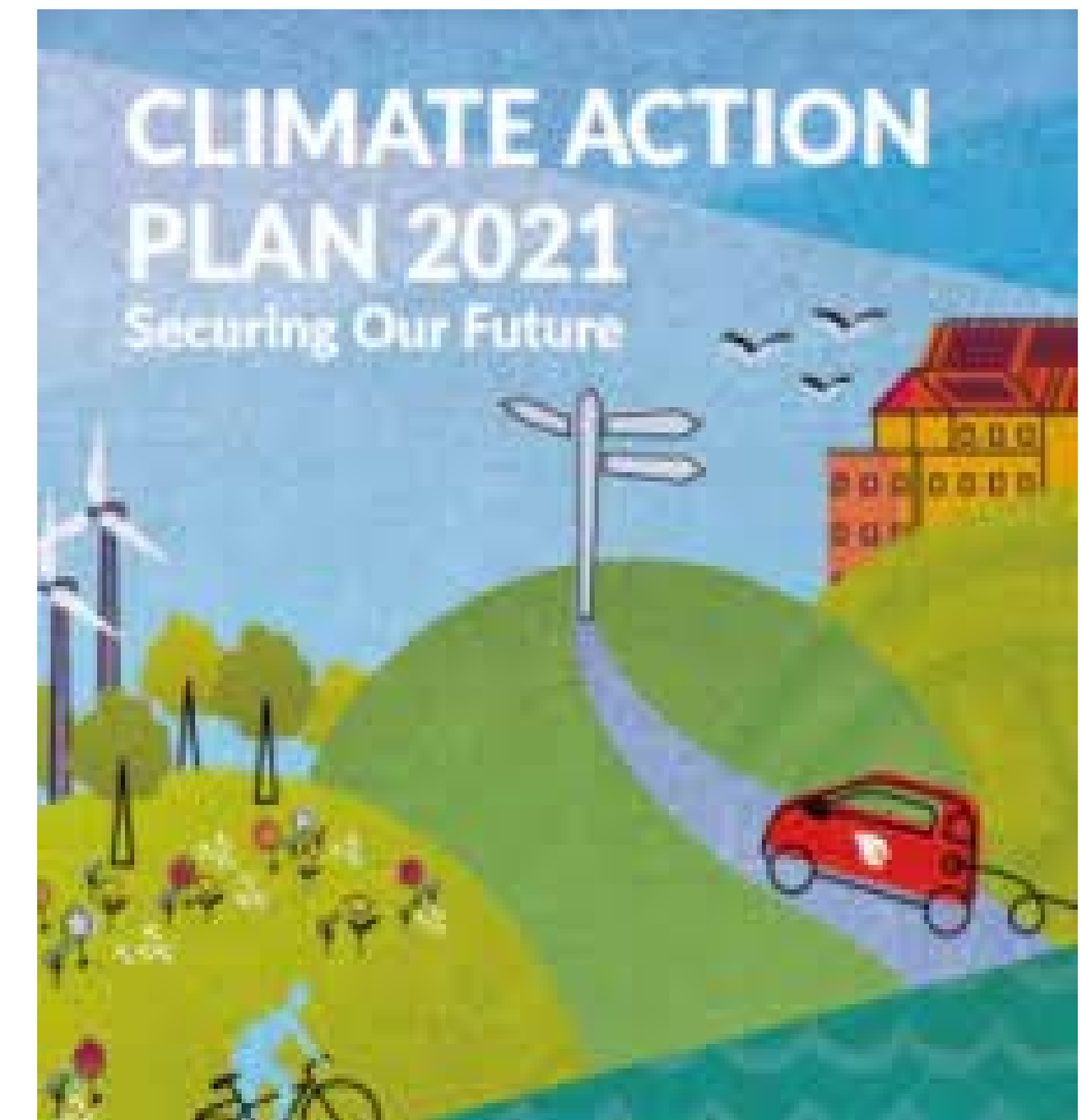

- Call for Expert Evidence 2022 sought evidence-based responses and submissions from experts, research organisations and other such groups/individuals that work in climate, environment and energy-related areas.

- Proposed actions focussed on:
- Identifying the skills required and development of appropriate response
- Implementing the skills recommendations from EGFSN's "Skills to Enable the Zero Carbon Economy to 2030"
- Introducing NZEB fundamentals in other relevant curricula
- Developing enterprise-relevant courses/micro-credentials for residential retrofitting, offshore renewable energy and green skills generally
